

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT FULL TEXT

Ballot Title: A Voter Registration Method for Eligible Floridians

Ballot Summary: A U.S. citizen eligible to vote in Florida shall be registered to vote or have their existing registration updated by submitting an application for a new, renewed, updated, or replacement Florida driver's license or ID card, unless they check a box to opt out of voter registration. The person shall not be required to select registration in order to be registered to vote or update registration. This amendment does not change voting eligibility requirements.

Article and Section Being Created or Amended: Article VI, Section 9

Full Text of the Proposed Amendment:

A voter registration method for eligible Floridians.—

(a) A citizen of the United States eligible to vote in the state shall be registered to vote or have their existing registration updated by submitting an application for a new, renewed, updated, or replacement Florida driver license or identification card, unless they check a box to opt out of voter registration. The person shall not be required to select registration in order to be registered to vote or update registration.

(b) This section does not change voting eligibility requirements.

(c) This section shall be effective May 1, 2023.
