CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT FULL TEXT

Ballot Title:

Expanded Medical Marijuana to Include Mental Health

Ballot Summary:

Expands the current definition of debilitating medical conditions, allowing the medical use of marijuana for mental health. Floridians suffering from mental health disorders such as Bipolar Disorder, Panic Disorder, Anorexia, Opioid Use Disorder, and other disorders will qualify as medical marijuana patients. Applies only to Florida law, and does not immunize violations of federal law.

Article and Section Being Created or Amended:

Article X, Section 29

Full Text of the Proposed Amendment:

ARTICLE X, SECTION 29.– Medical marijuana production, possession and use.

(b) DEFINITIONS. For purposes of this section, the following words and terms shall have the following meanings:

(1) "Debilitating Medical Condition" means cancer, epilepsy, glaucoma, positive status for human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS), post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), Crohn's disease, Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, <u>bipolar</u> <u>disorder</u>, <u>opioid use disorder</u>, <u>panic disorder</u>, <u>anorexia nervosa</u>, <u>bulimia nervosa</u>, <u>insomnia disorder</u>, <u>alcohol</u> <u>use disorder</u>, <u>generalized anxiety disorder (GAD)</u>, <u>major depressive disorder (MDD</u>), or other debilitating medical conditions of the same kind or class as or comparable to those enumerated, and for which a physician believes that the medical use of marijuana would likely outweigh the potential health risks for a patient.
